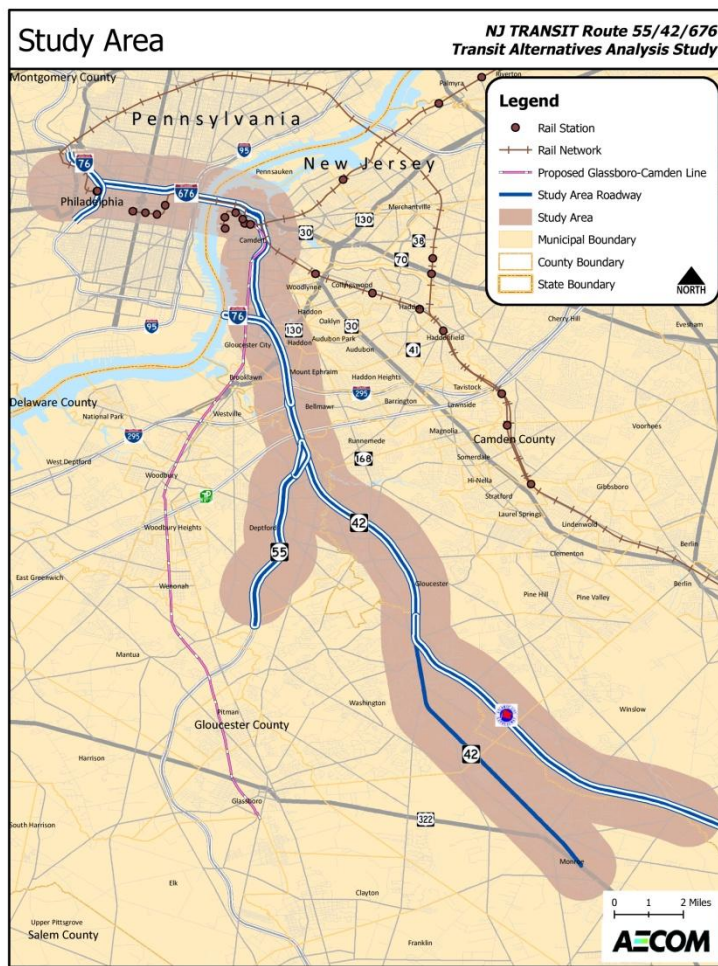




Please Join Us - Public Open House

NJ TRANSIT has initiated a study of potential transit improvements in southern New Jersey in the vicinity of the Route 55/42/676 travel corridor to/from Camden and Philadelphia. The study is looking at innovative service options, including Bus Rapid Transit, designed to speed travel along this heavily congested corridor.

The study will identify and evaluate a range of transit improvements. NJ TRANSIT is seeking input from the public at the open house meeting. Members of the public are invited to drop by anytime between 4pm and 7pm to view display boards, interact with the project team, and offer comments.

The study is following Federal Transit Administration (FTA) study guidelines and may potentially qualify for funds within FTA's New Starts/Small Starts program.
